Additional covid safety Information for hirers of Arts Centre rooms during the period of time when the building is waiting for major repairs

At the time of writing, the Arts Centre building at 2-4 West Street is waiting for major structural repairs. The building is safe to use in all areas except the entrance staircase which rises from the no 2 West Street door, with the stair lift.

The ceiling above this staircase is open and leaks badly in wet weather. There is also a danger of falling debris from the roof space. It is therefore out of bounds, except for emergency escape if there is a fire.

There are other roof leaks which are currently only causing staining to the ceilings.

The one-way system which was set up in the building last summer cannot be used, as it relied on entry up the closed off staircase.

Room hirers are therefore advised to let their group members know about this situation and to request that when they arrive for your activity in room 1 upstairs, they enter the outside door nearest the café, and proceed quickly up the café staircase. At the top, they should continue right along the short corridor, through room 2, exiting room 2 by the other door which is next to the door of Room 1 on the events room corridor.

2-metre distancing must be observed when moving through the building, face-masks must be worn, hand sanitizer (available on the left as you enter the building) must be used.
