We're very excited to let you know that CAP has been awarded its first grant - from Chamber Music Scotland - to run a series of concerts 2025 - 2026.

There will be some treats in store! We'll give you full details at the beginning of September.

This year CAP is once more offering the Penicuik Turner Prize for the best work in our Annual Open Art Show as judged by a professional artist. This year the judge will be Jane Kelly.

Because of our recently changed circumstances, this year we are asking work to be submitted in a standard format: 6 inches x 8 inches, unframed.

If you think this is rather small just think of the vast landscapes Turner and Constable managed to evoke on this scale!

Works should be submitted by 22nd August 2025 3 - 4pm at the Storehouse, 22 High Street, Penicuik, EH26 8HW.

Alternatively, you're invited to post your entries, complete with their forms with your full details, to Jackie McDonald, 4a Kirkhill Gardens, Penicuik, EH26 8JE.

We do hope you will accept this challenge and support the new organisation as it tries to keep up the work of the old Penicuik Community Arts
Association, providing outlets for the artistic talent in our area.

We sincerely hope that by next year we will have identified a gallery capable of hosting a full Penicuik Turner Prize.
