Entry requirements

- You can submit up to 3 works 6 inches x 8 inches (15cm x 20cm) Board is preferred. Art work on paper should be mounted on board. You can buy supplies from Pen-y-Coe Press, 7 Bridge Street, Penicuik
- The work should be unframed
- There is no hanging fee this year.
- Please complete one entry form per artist and write your name, the name of the work, medium and price on the back of the work.
- Commission on work is 30% (15% to the Storehouse and 15% to CAP)
- Work can be handed in to The Storehouse, 22 High Street Penicuik EH26 8HW between 1.30pm and 3.30pm on Saturday the 22nd of August 2025.
- There will be a prize-giving social event at the Storehouse on Sunday 6th September 2026 2-3pm.
- Unsold work should be collected between 3.00pm and 4.00pm on Sunday the 6th of September 2025
- If it is not possible to hand in or collect works at the designated times please contact Morag Barry to make alternative arrangements
- Please note that art work will be fixed to a mounting board at the Storehouse using velcro pads. Each art work will have velcro pads stuck to the back.
- The exhibition will be staffed full time by a CAP board member, or exhibiting artist. Please let us know if you are willing to sit with the exhibition, keep sales records and mark sold work with red dots for a three hour shift in the Storehouse.

The Penicuik Turner Prize and People's Choice

The PCAA annual show is open to all and a selected artist will be awarded Penicuik's Turner Prize, donated by Andrew Turner, Blacksmiths, Penicuik.

The judge this year is Rob Airey. Rob is the Director of the Wilhelmina Barns-Graham Trust, a single artist charitable Trust with manages the estate of the leading 20th century British artist and funds residencies and bursaries for artists at different stages of their career.

There will also be an award for the best work of art voted for by the public. The trophy for the People's Choice was designed by Jan Miller, another well known local artist.

Any piece that has been rejected by the hanging committee can be collected at the end of the exhibition as above or by arrangement with the organiser.
